### **Start of new B.Sc. study course "Landscape Architecture" in Geisenheim**

Winter Term 2005/06: New Bachelor Study Course „Landscape Architecture“ accredited and established together with new Master Study Course UMIB (Environmental Management and Infrastructural Planning in Congested Urban Areas). Due to the great demand on the part of high-school graduates entrance restrictions had to be reverified and the first 60 students have enrolled into the new study course.

The study course is diversified and allows for successive specialization and focussing in the areas: open space planning, gardening-, sports field- and landscape architecture. A comprehensive (modular) manual was compiled.

The old diploma study course will expire so that the University of Applied Sciences Wiesbaden is among the first universities in Germany that have already accomplished the conversion in the area landscape architecture and are into realisation.
